


Raleigh Memorial Auditorium

at Duke Energy Center for the Performing Arts



Opened in 1932, **Raleigh Memorial Auditorium** is the crown jewel of North Carolina performing arts. Over the years, this richly historic venue has played host to a dazzling spectrum of artists and performances. Just a sample of the list quickly becomes dizzying: Sinatra, Jerry Seinfeld, Norah Jones, Alice in Chains, Chris Tucker, and Shreya Ghoshal. Broadway blockbusters like *Les Misérables, The Phantom of the Opera*, Disney's *The Lion King, Jersey Boys, Miss Saigon,* and *Rent* have also been staged here.

After some dramatic renovations ranging from 1975-76, 1990, 2001, and most recently 2016, Raleigh Memorial Auditorium now blends state-of-the-art technical amenities with grand theatre traditions. Stepping into the theater – with its dramatic atrium lobby, twin floating staircases, and gorgeous Doric columns – brings the magic and inspiration of all these artists to life for guests.

A.J. Fletcher Opera Theater













Meymandi Concert Hall at Duke Energy Center for the Performing Arts






Kennedy Theatre at Duke Energy Center for the Performing Arts

LOADING DOCK

- Loading Dock Door: 7'-0" x 7'-0" double wide door 24" above street level
- Loading bay area: 8'-0" x 14'-0" space leading to the south east corner of the theater

STAGE DIMENSIONS

- Stage floor is 40'-0" x 59'-0" of working space
- Stage floor is tongue and groove maple painted black. Absolutely no screws or lags of any kind many be used
- There is a pipe grid 26'-0" above stage level laid out in a 4'-0" x 4'-0" grid. Pipe is 1.5' schedule 40

DRESSING ROOMS

- There is one large 17'-0" x 31'-0" dressing room at stage level
- There one men's and one women's restroom in the dressing room
- There is a washer and dryer located in the dressing room

AUDIO SYSTEM

- There is no permanent sound system in this space
- There is a program feed that can be sent to the dressing room and lobby from a single microphone hanging over the stage

LIGHTING SYSTEM

- There is a 100A company switch located in the balcony
- There is no set house light plot and all lighting must be setup on a per production basis
- A variety of Colortran ellipsoidal stage lights are available

Centerplate also offers full service catering and can ensure a seamless, successful, and enjoyable event.

Merchandise

Centerplate also holds the exclusive retail rights and as such retains 25% of soft merchandise (t-shirts, hats, hoodies, etc) and 10% of hard merchandise (CD's, books, etc). Staffing for merchandise tables can also be provided at the rate of \$15 per hours with a 4-hour minimum.
